



Architectural and Urban Contemporary Heritage- ARURCOHE, is an Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Programme (EMJM) which is open to holders of an official higher education degree from one or more universities in the field of architecture, civil engineering, urban planning or similar.

The application period is now open for 3 types of student status: scholarship students, non-scholarship students partially funded by the programme, and non-scholarship students who fully self-finance their participation.

Applicants are expected to have a higher education degree according to the following criteria: successful completion of a 5-year (300 ECTS) university study program (graduated architects, urbanists, civil engineers, architectural engineers and similar) associated to a regulated profession.
