

EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION AND TEACHING SKILLS FOR ENGLISH-MEDIUM HIGHER EDUCATION (C1 LEVEL)

Introduction: Who is the course for?

The course is designed to further the English-medium teaching skills of university lecturers who are currently teaching their subject in English. The course is both practical and reflective, and teachers are encouraged to relate the course sessions to their own teaching context and experience.

Participants should have a **C1 level** of English and be accredited to teach their subject in English.

Course Objectives:

Participants will have the opportunity to update their EMI skills through focussing on university communication contexts such as lectures, seminars, and tutorials.

Expected learning outcomes

Participants will:

- share their experience of teaching in English in order to explore the difficulties encountered and to discuss possible solutions.
- analyse and review current teaching practices and advance their communication skills through online micro-teaching sessions and presentations with peer review and tutor feedback.
- up-date their language skills and improve their confidence and fluency in oral discourse through a variety of focused activities.
- view tools and resources for further professional development.

Course contents:

According to the needs of the group, the following topics will be considered:

EMHE for:

- Lecturing and presenting skills and language
- CALP & BICS
- Focus on pronunciation
- Supporting students' listening
- Thinking skills and questioning
- Giving feedback to students

- Hybrid teaching and the flipped classroom

Course assessment:

To have successfully completed the course, participants will be required to:

- complete at least 80% of the 25 hours of the course.
- complete the set tasks.
- participate actively in class.

Course duration and dates:

The course consists of 5 x 5 hour sessions. (25 hours)
